What Positions are available in Retail?

There are a variety of volunteer positions available within the Lifeline Retail Team.

We appreciate that everyone has their own story, preferences and skills and are happy to work with potential volunteers to find the perfect position.

Please find below a quick summary of some of the key positions within our Retail Team.

SHOP ASSISTANT

- Do you love to provide great customer service?
- Do you love meeting new people and helping them find a gem?

As a Shop Assistant you will assist and support the Shop Manager in the day to day running of the Lifeline Shop. Tasks include assisting customers, point of sale, merchandising stock and general shop duties.

SORT ASSISTANT

- Do you have a great eye for detail?
- Do you like upcycling, vintage, retro and designer clothing?
- · Do you get excited when you find a gem?

Then a LLD sorter role might be the perfect role for you!

As a sorter you will assist by classify and process incoming donations to go out to our local Lifeline Shops based on their target markets.

TRUCK OFFSIDER

- Do you like to be out in the community?
- Are you comfortable and physically able to safely move goods including furniture?

Then a Truck Offsider role might be perfect for you!

The Truck Offsider role is to support the Truck Driver in the daily activities including the safe and timely supply, collection and delivery of goods to the retail shops and customer's homes.

About Lifeline

At Lifeline our vision is Australia free of suicide, a society where no one person feels like they have to face their darkest moments alone.

- Nine Australians die every day by suicide. That's more than double the road toll.
- Over 65,000 Australians make a suicide attempt each year.
- In 2019, 3,318 Australians took their own life.
- 75% of those who take their own life are male.
- Suicide is the leading cause of death for Australians between the ages of 15 and 44.
- The suicide rate in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples is twice that of their non-Indigenous counterparts.
- People in rural populations are 2 times more likely to die by suicide.
- LGBTQI+ community members experience significantly higher rates of suicide than the rest of the population.
- Our 13 11 14 is receiving up to 90,000 calls per month
- That is a person reaching out every 30 seconds
- 25% increase in calls 2020 largest call volume since the inception of the service 57 years ago was in April & August.
